

EMC WiFi reset - Onsite

You first must log into the E-Gear wifi configuration page. There are 2 options to choose from.

Login in option #1: Using the USER Ethernet port (RJ45)

Plug an Ethernet cable from a computer into the lower USER port on the EMC Ethernet ports.

Launch an internet browser on the computer and type in the following address into the header: **192.168.25.1**



Login in option #2: Using the USB port

Plug USB cable into Mini USB port located on the top center area of the EMC.

Launch an internet browser on the computer and type in the following address into the header: <u>https://10.3.2.1</u>





Once the security window appears, type in the following security credentials:
