

What is WPS (Push Button) and how to use it to reconnect my Enphase Envoy monitor

Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS) is a feature supplied with many routers. It is designed to make the process of connecting to a secure wireless network from a computer or other device easier.

NOTE: Some manufactures may use the following terms instead of WPS (Push Button) to describe this function.

Wi-Fi Simple Config Push 'n' Connect PBC Quick Secure Setup (QSS)

The WPS button on a router gives you an easier/quicker way to add wireless devices to your network. You can press the WPS button on your router and then press the WPS button on your wireless device to connect to the network rather than searching for the network and typing in a password.
